

## WINDSOR GUN CLUB RANGE RULES

1. Range to be used by members only. Member can bring the same guest only twice per year. It is recommended they join after the second visit. There is no limit on the number of guests invited.
2. Club Membership card must be carried on members person and shown when requested.
3. Members will close and lock the gate behind them when they enter and exit.
4. Members and guest must log in and out when at the range. Information: Name, time in, time out and date.
5. No one under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol will be allowed to use the range.
6. Eye and ear protection are required.
7. All Gun-handling safety rules shall be followed:
  - \* Always point the muzzle of a firearm in a safe direction.
  - \* Actions will remain open and unloaded until it is safe to fire.
  - \* No one is allowed to handle a firearm while people are downrange.
  - \* Cease-fires may be called by mutual consent of all shooters on the firing line.  
Firearms will be unloaded, magazines removed and actions locked open when a cease-fire is called.  
**ANYONE may call an emergency cease-fire.**
8. All shooters must position their target in front of and at the base of the appropriate berm and not at a partial distance between the firing line and berm.
9. No shooting outside designated firing lanes.
10. No glass , exploding or breakable targets (clay birds are allowed).  
Paper targets only.  
No rapid fire or bump fire.  
"Spinner" targets are allowed for .22's. Exceptions will be allowed for sanctioned events.
11. Shooter will pick up their spent brass, including .22's and used target materials and dispose of them in a proper manner.
12. Center fire rifle and slug shooters will not be allowed to use the 10 yard or 25 yard pistol ranges .  
Center fire rifle and slug shooters must use the 25 yard, 50 yard and 100 yard rifle ranges.
13. Trapshooting by individuals using their own equipment is permitted unless the rifle range is in use.
14. No rifle range use during regular trapshooting times.
15. No .50 BMG rifles allowed.
16. No shooting before sunrise or after sunset on the rifle and pistol ranges.
17. Shooters are required to observe and comply with these and any other rules posted on the range. Absent specific rules, all shooters will follow generally accepted firearm safety standards and use good common sense. As a firearm owner/user, YOU are responsible for your own actions. Anyone violating safety or range rules will be barred from the Club. Additional discipline will be reviewed by the Board of Directors and could result in various levels up to and including prosecution.
18. Members who observe safety or range violations without taking immediate action will be suspended with discipline as decided by the Board of Directors. Violators may be fined, suspended or expelled as decided by the Board of Directors.
19. New members must attend an orientation with a board member before their membership will go into effect. This can be done by attending a club meeting or making arrangements for a private orientation with a board member.

## MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

In consideration of participating in club shooting activities, and for other good and valuable consideration, I hereby agree to release and discharge from liability arising from negligence Windsor Gun Club and its owners, directors, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, participants, and all other persons or entities acting for them (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Releasees"), on behalf of myself and my children, parents, heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate, and also agree as follows:

1. I acknowledge that gun club or hunting activities involve known and unanticipated risks which could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis or permanent disability, death, and property damage. Risks include, but are not limited to, death or serious injury as a result of being shot or as a result of equipment malfunction; hearing loss; loss of vision; broken bones, bruises and other bodily injuries caused by falls; medical conditions resulting from physical activity and damaged clothing or other property. I understand such risks simply cannot be eliminated, despite the use of safety equipment, without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity.
2. I expressly accept and assume all of the risks inherent in this activity or that might have been caused by the negligence of the Releasees. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary and I elect to participate despite the risks. In addition, if at any time I believe that event conditions are unsafe or that I am unable to participate due to physical or medical conditions, then I will immediately discontinue participation.
3. I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless Releasees from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action which are in any way connected with my participation in this activity, or my use of their equipment or facilities, arising from negligence. This release does not apply to claims arising from intentional conduct. Should Releasees or anyone acting on their behalf be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs.
4. I represent that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I may suffer or cause while participating in this activity, or else I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage myself. I further represent that I have no medical or physical condition which could interfere with my safety in this activity, or else I am willing to assume -and bear the cost of -all risks that may be created, directly or indirectly, by any such condition.
5. In the event that I file a lawsuit, I agree to do solely in Shelby County Illinois, and I further agree that the substantive law of that state shall apply.
6. I agree that if any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect. By signing this document, I agree that if I am hurt or my property is damaged during my participation in this activity, then I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against the parties being released on the basis of any claim for negligence.

I, the undersigned agree that I hereby release the Windsor Gun Club from any liability for any injury either to person or property which I may suffer in connection with the use of the premises of said club. I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless said Windsor Gun Club of and from any injury or damage to any member of my family or any guest of mine, suffered while enjoying the privileges of the club or premises. This indemnification shall further extent to, and cover any owner, lessee, worker member, guest or any other person who, in whatsoever way, becomes liable to me or a member of my family, or any guest of mine, while enjoying the privileges of the club or premises. I also agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the Windsor Gun Club, whether made by the members or management, and the Fish and Game laws of the State of Illinois. I agree to loss of membership, without refund or membership fee, for violation of any club rules. Each member will be held responsible for their guest obeying all rules.

I have had sufficient time to read this entire document and, should I choose to do so, consult with legal counsel prior to signing. Also, I understand that this activity might not be made available to me if I were to choose not to sign this release. I have read and understood this document and I agree to be bound by its terms.
